Free School Meals

Communication from school meals service: Now your children have been back in school for a few weeks, we wanted to let you know that you are able to book your child's meal three weeks in advance and we hope this makes easier for you. To avoid disappointment, here are a couple of changes that you need to remember:

- orders need to be placed by 8am
- the list of children who have ordered a school meal cannot be updated after 8am so if you haven't ordered a meal, your child will need to bring a packed lunch

We kindly ask that if you have ordered a meal for your child and change your mind, please cancel the order before 8am on the day. The number of meals that are prepared each day is based on the number of orders received, so if you order a meal, but give your child a packed lunch, food will go to waste.
