



# RAIDERS, ROADS, AND REVOLTS: REVEALING THE MYSTERIES OF THE ROMANS AND CELTS!



## LITERACY, LANGUAGE & COMMUNICATION

This term, children will learn persuasive writing techniques, including rhetorical questions and emotive language. They will analyse persuasive texts and practice structuring arguments. As a creative project, they will design and write an advertisement for Roman sandals, integrating their literacy skills with Roman culture exploration.



## HUMANITIES

The children will be learning about a fascinating period of our history - when Wales was invaded by the Romans! Their inquiries will look at the difference between Celtic and Roman cultures, what life would have been like and what legacy was left behind. The children will even have a go at curating their very own museum!



## SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

The children will be getting hands on in our outdoor area, investigating and experimenting through the context of our Roman inquiry. They'll be experimenting with natural dyes, constructing shields and helmets, choosing the best materials to craft sandals and moving water by building an aqueduct.



## MATHEMATICS & NUMERACY

Multiplication and Division: Children will learn to use arrays, grouping, and repeated addition to solve multiplication and division problems, focusing on fluency with 2, 5, and 10 times tables in Year 2, and progressing to 3, 4, and 8 times tables in Year 3. They will also explore problem-solving and reasoning to apply their skills in real-world contexts.



## HEALTH AND WELLBEING

Each week the children in Dosbarth Ceiriog will attend swimming lessons - such a valuable life skill. They will be exploring and performing Roman Dance.

The children will be covering the Celebrate module of MyHappyMind and looking at their dreams and goals through Jigsaw for PSHE.
